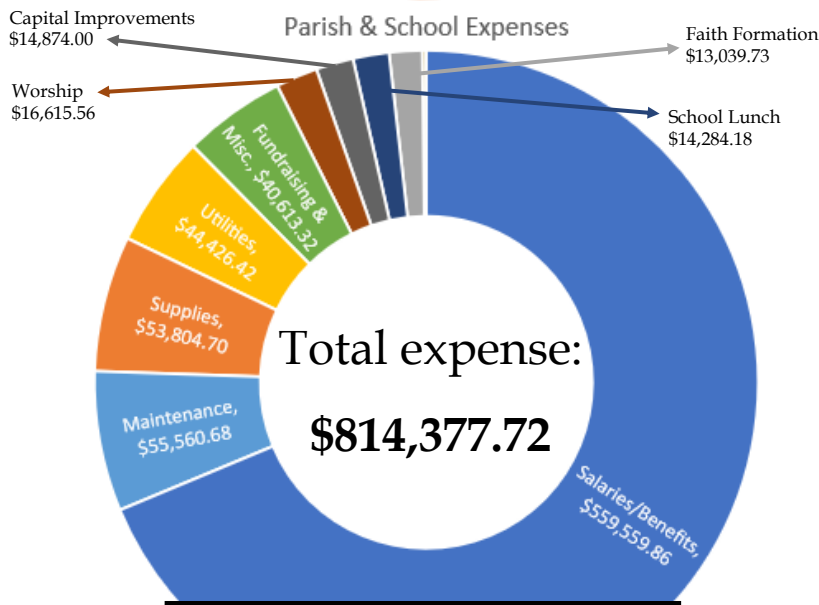
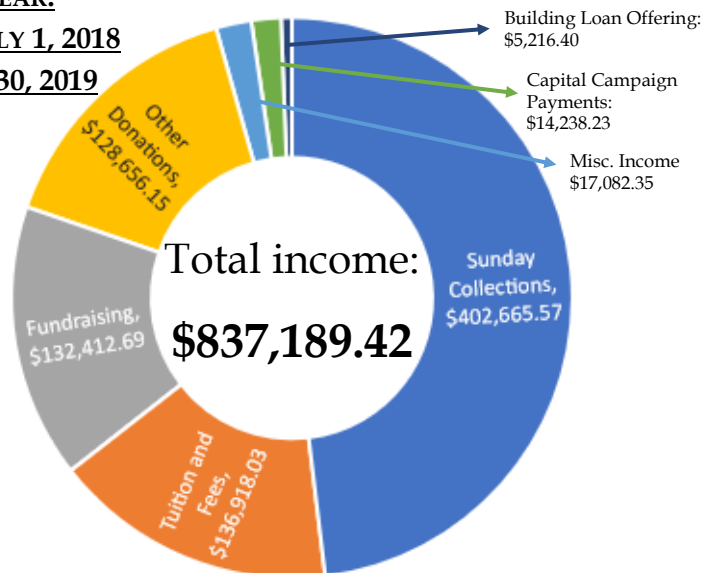

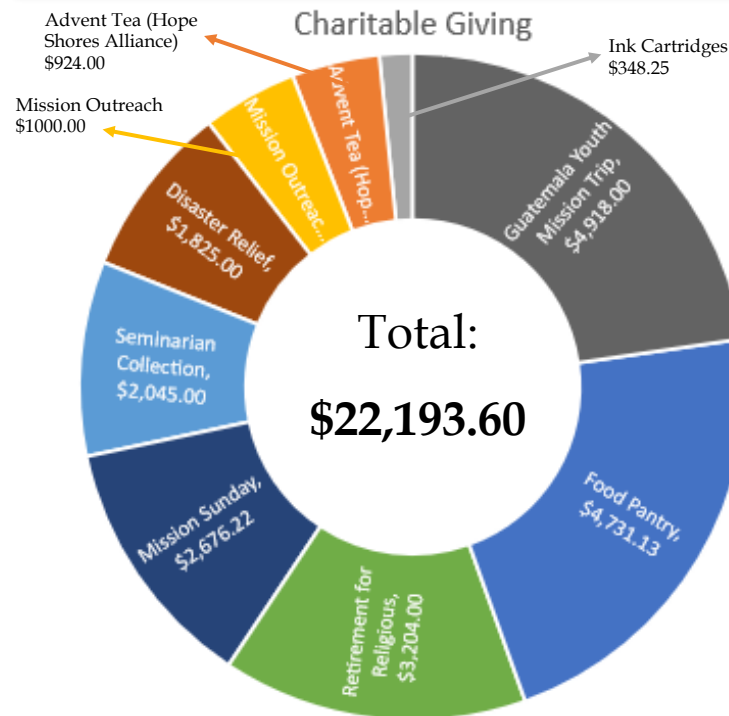
Parish & School Income

Endowment Funds:

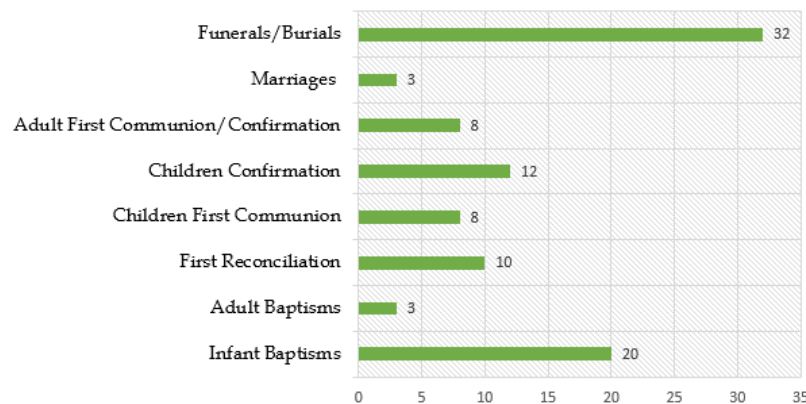

- **Cemetery Fund**—supports the perpetual care of our two parish cemeteries.

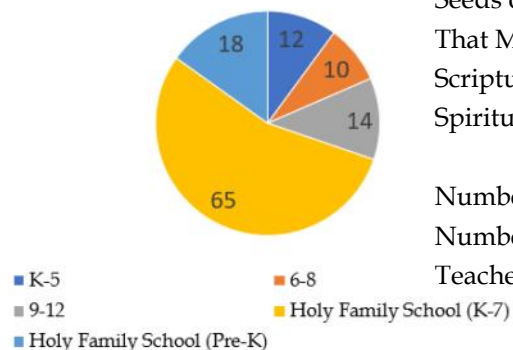
