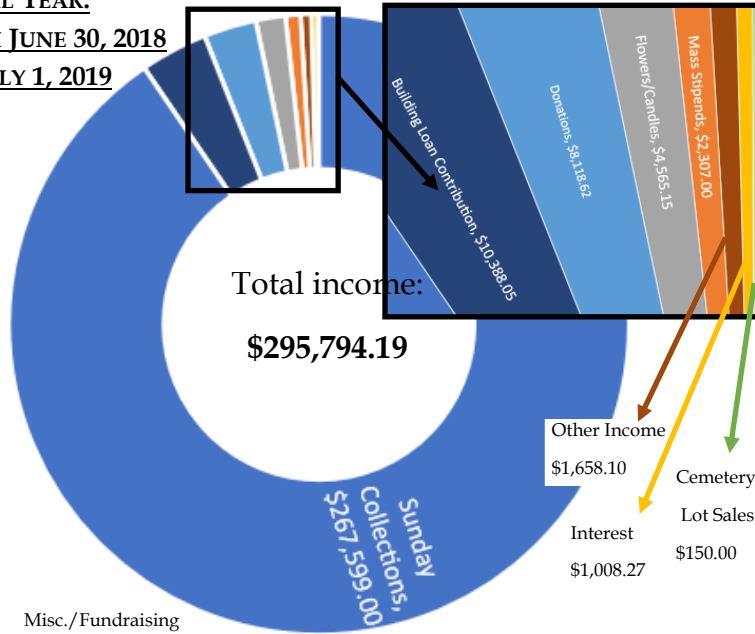


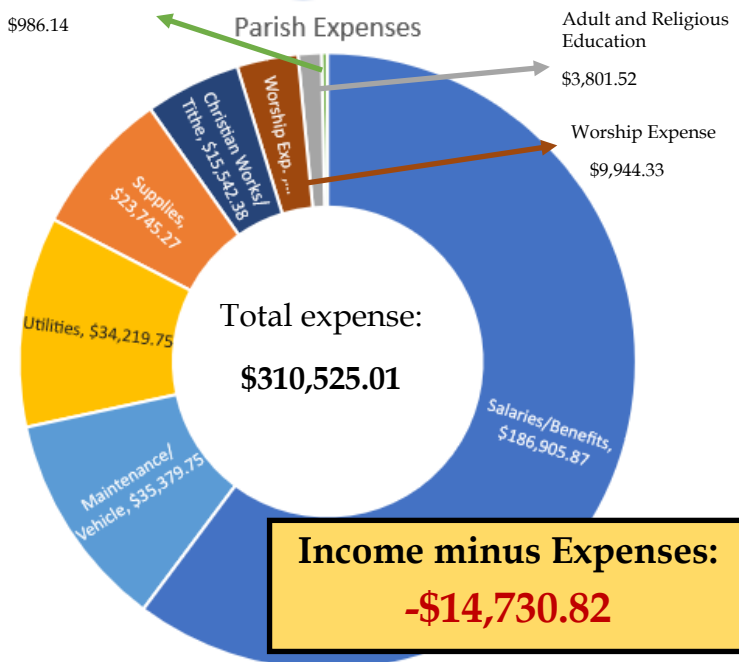

Parish Income



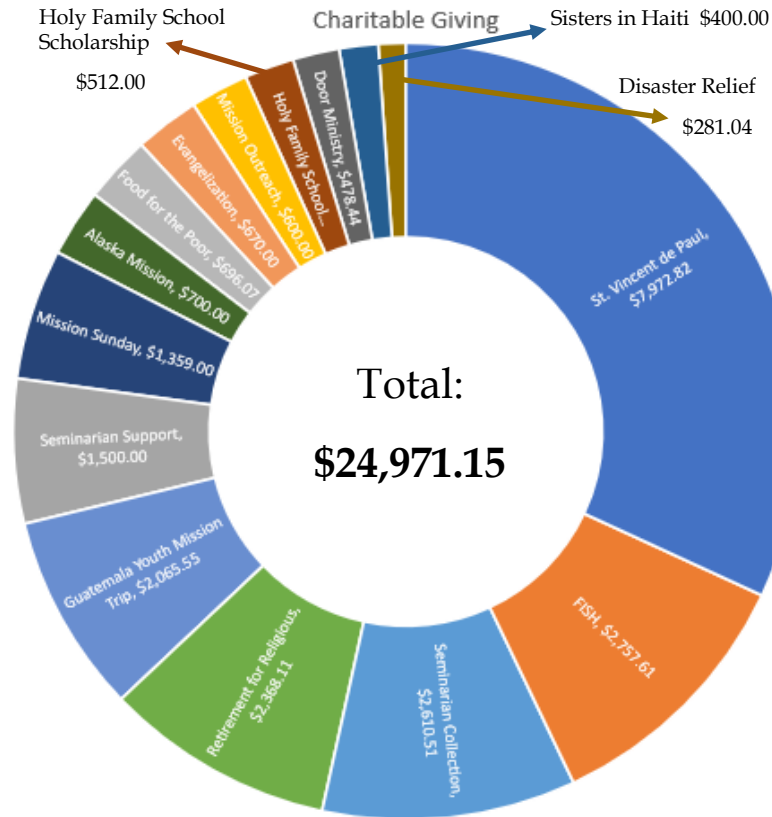
Parish Expenses

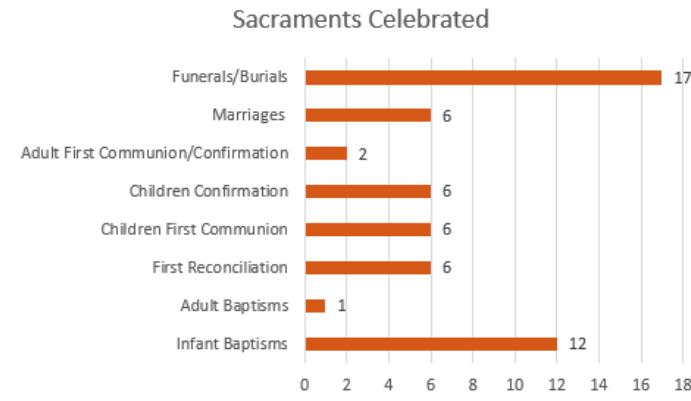
Endowment Funds:

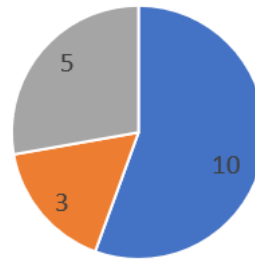
- **Fr. Mikulski Fund**—annual support to the ministry of the parish, building & grounds.
